



Camping Tips

Plan for hot and cold weather and the occasional rain shower.

- Comfortable shoes (note: closed-toe shoes & long pants are required for horseback riding)
- Jacket/coat and a rain poncho
- Hat (brimmed for sun protection)
- Bathing Suit
- Undergarments and warm socks
- Sweater or sweatshirt
- Dress-up items for themes (call if you have any questions)
- Sleepwear

Equipment:

- Sleeping Bag (must fit in a standard residential washing machine, no oversized bags or heavy quilted bags please as we won't be able to launder)
- Pillow and blanket
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen, lip balm and insect repellent
- Flashlight and batteries

Miscellaneous:

- Medications: Name of medication, dispensing instructions, prescribing physician's name and date must appear on the container. Over-the-counter medications must be in the original container and clearly labeled with the camper's name.
- Talent show items (call if you have questions)
- Special Foods if required, labeled with your camper's name.

Please leave the following items at home:

- Valuables such as CD players, hand held video games, cell phones, money or jewelry (we are not responsible for lost or stolen items)
- Snacks, candy, soda (food cannot be kept in the tents)
- Personal sports equipment
- Weapons of any kind – including Swiss Army knives, pen or jack-knives
- Alcoholic beverages and tobacco products
- Personal sports equipment
- Pets of any kind
