

## **EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS**

- On-site medical services are available to campers, staff and volunteers 24 hours per day by a Registered Nurse or Nurse Practitioner.
- The Registered Nurse or Nurse Practitioner will dispense all prescriptions and over-the-counter medications.
- Provided the Authorization for Medical Treatment has been signed by the parent/guardian, camper, staff member or volunteer, first aid for minor injuries or illnesses will be rendered by the nursing staff in accordance with CBNW guidelines.
- If more involved medical issues or questions arise, you will be contacted regarding the emergent care.

Transportation to Jefferson Healthcare will be provided by East Jefferson Fire Rescue, Camp Beausite NW staff or volunteers as deemed appropriate by the medical staff.

In the event we must evacuate Beausite Lake, campers will be transported to H.J. Carroll Park in Chimacum. The park is located approximately ¼ mile north from the Chimacum School Complex on Highway 19. Parents and guardians will be contacted by telephone if an evacuation occurs. If the emergency prevents us from returning to camp, parents/guardians shall be instructed to pick up their camper(s) at this location. If unfamiliar with H.J. Carroll Park, we encourage you to visit the site when dropping your camper off this summer.
